LOCAL CLUB RULES



Golf is a lot of fun, we need to be friendly and respect other players on the golf course.

- ❖ Large drains on the golf course are to be treated as a lateral hazard.
 - Which means you hit the golf ball out of the drain or take a penalty drop 2 club lengths from the drain, no closer to the hole.
- ❖ Preferred lie of one club length no closer to the hole on all fairways is in play in the wet season which begins the 1st of January until 1st April.
 - This enables you to clean the ball and drop it away from any bare patches on the fairway.
- ❖ If you hit the powerlines on hole 2 or 9 you can either play that ball or play another ball off the tee – no penalty.
- ❖ Free drop 2 club lengths from golf cart pathways.
- ❖ Any rubbish piles from trees or greenkeepers waste you have a free drop - two club lengths.
- ❖ All players must give way to greenkeepers.
- ❖ If you are having a slow golfer or you are having a bad round you must let the players behind you play through.
- ❖ Golf carts are not to be driven too close to the greens or on the tees. Carts must not be driven into drains or off the fairway. Please **RESPECT** the golf course and all golf course property.
- ❖ Do not hit up on players that are in front of you. (This is both dangerous and bad form)
